Following is a table describing the carryover provisions for the covered programs of ESEA. Local educational agencies (LEAs) are strongly encouraged to expend dollars in the year they were allocated.

Title I, Part A	LEAs are allowed to carry over up to 15% of their prior year's allocation. LEAs may apply for a waiver once within a three year period, seeking approval for utilization of the excess funds and including information on how these funds will be employed to meet program objectives.
