<b>March 31, 2008</b>	Applications due
<b>April 18, 2008</b>	Applicants receive eligibility notices: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Eligible for funding under community approach priority: notice will indicate eligibility for funding and provide a preliminary estimate of the potential grant amount based on projected enrollments submitted with applications.</li><li>▪ Eligible for funding but not for community approach priority: notice will indicate if any funds are provided in this category and if so a preliminary estimate of the grant amount based on projected enrollments submitted with applications.</li><li>▪ Not eligible for funding: notice that applicant is not eligible under either category and the reason why they are not eligible.</li></ul>
<b>June 15, 2008</b>	Eligible districts can withdraw from the grant program if it determines it will not offer 4k in the fall.
<b>July 15, 2008</b>	Web update on preliminary estimate of grant.
<b>September 19, 2008</b>	Submission of 3 <sup>rd</sup> Friday pupil count on PI 1563
<b>November, 2008</b>	Notice of preliminary estimate of award based on unaudited student count
<b>June 9, 2009</b>	Final award and payment
