

# Service-Learning Projects

## Sample Ideas

- Parenting classes conduct a weekly story hour for 2-4 year olds.
- Foods classes research healthy snacks, test them out on kids, and create a snack cookbook to give free to parents.
- Building and Construction classes create a pier by the local pond for science classes to test water.
- Fabrication classes make adaptive equipment for the OI/CDS classroom.
- Third-graders study the theme "Traditions" and create a quilt to send to Hurricane Katrina victims.
- Art classes paint a mural at local nursing home.
- Graphic Arts students make Buckle Up safety signs for school parking lot.
- US History classes interview war veterans and create an oral history book of their stories.
- Science classes test water quality of Cedar Creek, participate in a Bald Eagle count, and submit results to local DNR office.
- Mass Media classes produce a PSA commercial to promote safe driving, and submit to DMV stations to show for patrons.
- Photography students create a collage of pictures of people in the community wearing their seat belts, and make posters to display around school and in the community.
- Basic Electricity students partner up with the Boy Scouts or 4<sup>th</sup> graders to teach them about circuitry.
- Lifetime Fitness students create a workout book for children, parents, or seniors.
- Animals, Plants & You or Horticulture students design a garden for local nursing home.
- Photography students help Washington County "Celebrate Families" by taking family pictures free of charge at annual event.
- Architecture students design an improvement for the school.
- Accounting students perform Tax Education Day for students and faculty.
