International Organization for Standardization (ISO) (<http://www.iso.ch/>)

ISO is the standards body that establishes standards for the international exchange of goods and services.

10161-1 and 10161-2 Information Retrieval: Application Service Definition and Protocol Specification. This standard defines the functionality of an interlibrary loan management system. This standard also defines how different interlibrary loan management systems can exchange data making it possible to include requests that originated in multiple interlibrary loan systems into a single request database.

There is no free online access to this standard. However, following is a link to a paper, "Improving Interoperability of Interlending and Document Delivery Systems," presented by Mary E. Jackson to the 67th IFLA Council and General Conference, August 16-25, 2001 that discusses the standard.
