Dollar\$ For Day\$



Restorative Justice allows you to make up for your mistakes in a manner directly related to the infraction. What better way to pay your truancy fine than to attend school regularly.



If you attend school regularly, get good grades and do not get into any trouble you may just end up liking it!



Dollar\$ For Day\$ Defined

Students with **truancy fines** will be able to work off their fines by attending school regularly. You will be paid for consistently attending school with **Bonu\$ Buck\$** being earned through good behavior, sport or club participation, earning passing grades (C or better, 3 class minimum), and homework bonus.

The Dollars for Days program is not limited to just the first truancy ticket. If you failed to work off your first ticket through the program and receive a second truancy fine students are still given the opportunity to try the Dollar\$ For Day\$ program again to work off additional truancy fines.



How to earn Dollar\$ for Day\$

- \$20 per week (A week is considered 5 consecutive school days)
- If you miss a day of school the 5 consecutive days starts over with the day you return to school

Bonu\$ Buck\$

- 4 week bonus- \$20
 (4 consecutive weeks)
- Passing grades- \$10/month (C or better-3 class minimum)
- Homework Bonus-\$10/month (no missing assignments in all classes)
- Sports bonus- **\$5/month**
- Club bonus-\$2/month (must be an active member)

Stipulations

- Partial days do not count unless the day is a shortened day by the school
- All absences must be medically or court excused or will not be considered for payment
- Medical/court absences are not paid or counted but will not count against bonus opportunities
- 10 individual tardy count as 1 truant day
- Contracts may carry over to the following year
- All students are eligible
- Students will be dropped from the program if they become habitually truant (5 unexcused absences from class)
